We value positive parent and educator relationships and partnerships. The educators, aim to meet your child's needs, to follow their interests, to challenge them and to document their progress and development. We also aim to work with you to best meet the individual needs of your child. We aim to provide you with information about your child's day at Preschool, their progress and development, through daily conversations on arrival and departure. If you have any concerns or questions during your time at Flying Fox Mobile Preschool, please meet with staff to organise a time to discuss your ideas and concerns. Arrival and departure times are a great time for us to share news of your child's day, progress and achievements.

Please understand that this can be a very busy time. During arrival and departure times the teachers are greeting and talking to family members, supervising the children and assisting them when necessary. It may be easier for us to talk to you in the afternoon, after the other children and families have departed or you can organise another time when the teaching staff can discuss questions more conveniently and effectively. During these early days it may be stressful for you to separate from your child if they are upset. We understand how difficult this is for you and we suggest that you telephone the Preschool to ask how your child is progressing. It is easier for us, because we see your child settle and play happily with the other children, enjoying their time at Preschool. But for you, those tears remain a memory for the rest of the day. We will be honest about how your child is settling at preschool. Your child's happiness is our primary goal.

Be positive and tell your child they are going to have a fun and happy day. Your positive approach to departure is an important first step to a settle, happy and confident child.

Teachers Days of Work and Qualifications

The Board of Directors and Educators thank you for following COVID requirements. It has been a challenging time for everyone and Wingham Preschool/ Flying Fox Preschool leaders have been proactive in keeping up with the constant changes in requirements to keep everyone as safe as possible.

The current practices followed by all Early Childhood Services includes:

To limit the risk of COVID-19 transmission during drop offs and pick-up Flying Fox Preschool will continue to follow the following procedures by:

- Asking parents to social distance during drop-off and pick-up times.
- Requesting that parents/carers drop-off and pick up their child/ren at the preschool entrance/exit without entering the indoor/outdoor areas of the service premises where possible. Educators will collect children from the service entrance/exit.
- Requesting all parents/carers to wear face masks and check-in using the NSW OR code during drop-off/pick-up periods (even if this occurs at the service entrance/exit).

It is important parents, families, educators and all members in our local community remain diligent with COVID-19 safety requirements as currently there is a number of cases in our local region.

Please remember to pack your child's hat for preschool.


As the weather is getting warmer we will be including more water activities during outdoor time, so we ask you to please pack spare clothes in case of a water accident.


Enclosed shoes are the best option for children to wear to preschool this is to ensure safety while climbing and running. Some of our venues also have grass containing bindi and clover which is attracting the bees. Please ensure your child is wearing enclosed shoes preferably joggers each day.

Preschool Fees

to be paid by the fourth week of term.

The State Government is covering the cost of children's fees for two days each week in 2022. Everyone will be issued with two fee accounts each term, outlining the cost of fees, the cost covered by the government and any costs for a third day.






If you have outlined on the fees agreement that you wish to pay each week or fortnight, you can begin payments now and you will receive a receipt after the administration assistant, Megan, has processed the payment (ie. after Tuesday or Friday). For term one 2022, if you are paying for a third day, your first fee payment will need to be made by the 18th February 2022. All fee

accounts will need to be finalized by the 18th March 2022. Please talk to Donna or Megan if you have any questions. If you are applying for fee subsidy, the forms for application and a copy of your health care card, are due by Friday 11th February. If you have not been issued with a form, please ask a teacher for a subsidy form and return ASAP. If you do not apply for subsidy before the due date, we will assume you are not eligible for subsidy and you will be charged full fees for the term.

If parents wish to pay their fees by direct deposit, please note that the Preschool bank details are printed on the bottom of all invoices and statements for your information.

If parents wish to use 'Centrepay', then the preschool has applied for a number and forms are available from the office to use this payment method.



Flying Fox Mobile Preschool has strategies in place to eliminate high risks for children with anaphylaxis. Please support preschool policy and procedure by ensuring your child washes their hands on arrival each day. Educators supervise children at all times including meal times. All educators have current First Aid training including anaphylaxis and asthma training.
