## **Educator and Family Partnerships**

We value positive parent and educator relationships and partnerships. The educators and I, aim to meet your child's needs, to follow their interests, to challenge them and to document their progress and development. We also aim to work with you to best meet the individual needs of your child.

We aim to provide you with information about your child's day at Preschool, their progress and development, through daily conversations on arrival and departure. If you have any concerns or questions during your time at Wingham Preschool, please meet with staff to organise a time to discuss your ideas and concerns. Arrival and departure times are a great time for us to share news of your child's day, progress and achievements.

Arrival and Departure times are a valuable time to share information, but are also a busy time. Educators are greeting and talking to family members, bus drivers and supervising the children and assisting them when necessary. It may be easier for us to talk to you in the afternoon, after the other children and families have departed or you can organise another time when the educators can discuss questions more conveniently and effectively.

During these early days it may be stressful for you to separate from your child if they are upset. We understand how difficult this is for you and we suggest that you telephone the Preschool to ask how your child is progressing. It is easier for us, because we see your child settle and play happily with the other children, enjoying their time at Preschool. But for you, those tears remain a memory for the rest of the day. We will be honest about how your child is settling at preschool. Your child's happiness is our primary goal.

Be positive and tell your child they are going to have a fun and happy day. Your positive approach to departure is an important first step to a settle, happy and confident child.

### Reminders...

- Please remember to update any information on your child's details when things change—phone numbers, addresses and emergency contacts are most important to keep up to date. We also require up to date immunisation registers once children have received their 4 yr old immunisation, this can be send via text or email or brought in.
- Please pack spare clothes and a hat

## **Preschool Fees**

The State Government is covering the cost of children's fees for two days each week in 2023 if you have completed the fee relief declaration form and submitted it to Wingham Preschool. Everyone will be issued with two fee accounts each term, outlining

the cost of fees, the cost covered by the government and any costs for a third day.

The first fee account will be issued in week one for the first five weeks of term. This fee account is due to be paid by the fourth week of term. This account includes the one off membership fee. The second fee account will be issued in week six, for the remaining five or six weeks of term. This account is due by week eight of term.

If you wish to begin payments now, you will receive a receipt after the administration assistant, Megan, has processed the payment (i.e. after Tuesday or Friday).

For term one 2023, if you are paying for a third day, your first fee payment will need to be made by the 24th February 2023. All fee accounts will need to be finalized by the 17th March 2023. Please talk to Donna or Megan if you have any questions. If you are applying for fee subsidy, the forms for application and a copy of your health care card, are due by Friday 10th February. If you have not been issued with a form, please ask a teacher for a subsidy form and return ASAP. If you do not apply for subsidy before the due date, we will assume you are not eligible for subsidy and you will be charged full fees for the term.

If parents wish to pay their fees by direct deposit, please note that the Preschool bank details are printed on the bottom of all invoices and statements for your information.
